



## Kid's Zone Leadership Guidelines

1. Leaders are to be faithful to attend Winter Haven Worship Center, as well as be faithful to serve in Kid's Zone when you are scheduled.
1. When you are scheduled to teach in Kid's Zone, please arrive on time.
1. Leaders are expected to be prepared both spiritually and naturally. Lessons are given out a week in advance so that you may study and memorize your parts. Also, prepare your heart by prayer and listening to the Holy Spirit.
1. As a leader, you are an example for the children. Therefore, in Kid's Zone and out of Kid's Zone, you are to lead a Godly lifestyle in your word and deed.
1. Leaders are not to be alone with a child at any time~ for any reason. If a child is a disciplinary problem, needs their parent, or is sick, etc., inform the head teacher. The head teacher will then give instructions according to the situation.
1. Leaders are to inform the head teacher if a child desires prayer for a situation. The head teacher, along with KZ leaders will agree in prayer with the child.
1. Please inform the head teacher of any child who is injured while in KZ. The head teacher will follow up with the child and inform the appropriate WHWC staff member.
1. The staff of WHWC cares for all church members. Therefore, if a child shares any personal information with you that requires attention or prayer, please inform the head teacher, so that a report can be supplied to the appropriate personnel.
1. Leaders are always friendly and warm to parents and children. However, hand shakes and smiles are the accepted forms of affection that may be shown toward children.
